Enhancing Environments with Safe Curtains

The ability to safely have curtains in patient spaces creates a less institutional environment, bringing more colour and improved acoustics. It also allows the patient to control daylight, which is an important factor for autonomy. The J-Trac rail system is self-harm and suicide resistant, designed to meet challenges in mental health environments to foster a caring, safe, and healing environment. The runners are designed to release at a maximum load of 4 kg over 12 runners, and the specially designed aluminum rail and end caps are sloped to prevent ligature attachment.



Features

- Self-harm and suicide resistant design
- Anti-ligature rail shape is sloped
- Powder-coated aluminum construction
- Easy to install
- Runners release when an abnormal load is added (4kg for 12 runners)
- The runners are designed so that even if multiple are pulled together, they rotate and come off the rail
- Lifetime warranty against manufacturing defects on the rail and end caps
